## **Directions To The Show Site**

From East - Baltimore Area

I-70 W to I-70 W/I-76 W toward Pittsburgh (Toll)

Continue on I-76 W. Take exit 28 to merge onto I-79 N toward Erie. Take exit 96 for PA-488 toward Portersville/Prospect. Follow US-19 N and PA-108 W/Harlansburg Rd to Livestock Alley in Hickory Township. Turn left onto PA-488 W/E Portersville Rd. Turn right onto US-19 N. Pass by First National Bank (on the left). Turn left onto PA-108 W/Harlansburg Rd. Turn left onto Midway Rd. Turn right onto Livestock Alley. Destination will be on the right.

From East - New York Area

I-80 W into Pennsylvania (Toll Bridge) Take exit 19A to merge onto I-79 S toward Pittsburgh. Take exit 105 toward PA-108 W. Turn right onto PA-108 W

Turn left onto Bodziach Rd. Turn left onto Midway Rd. Turn right onto Livestock Alley. Destination will be on the right.

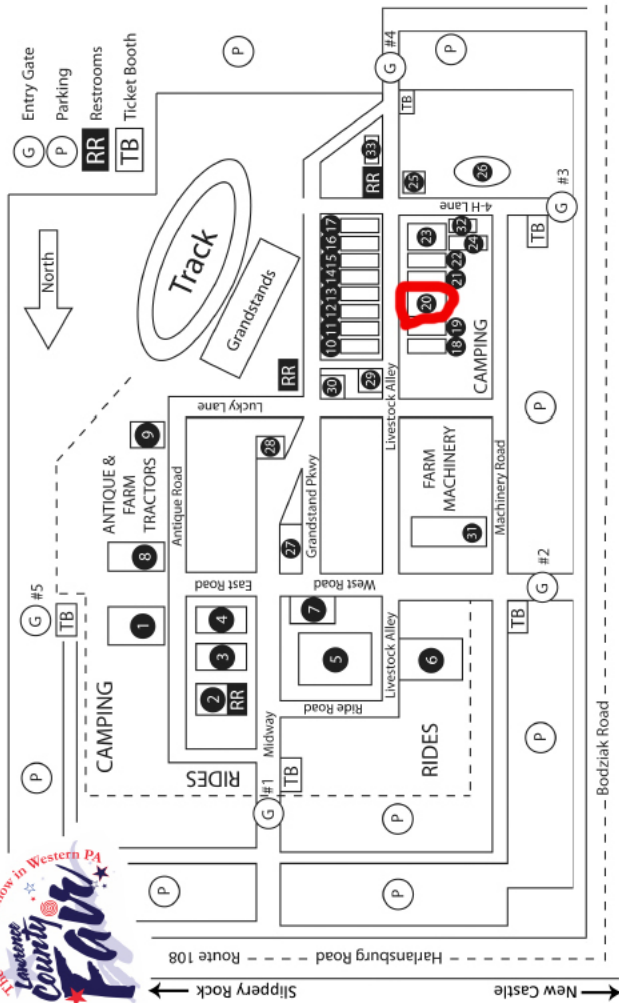
From South - Charlotte NC Area

I-77 N - Entering Virginia - Entering West Virginia - Toll Rd - Take Exit 48 to I-79 N. - Entering Pennsylvania - stay on I-79 N. Use the right 2 lanes to merge onto I-70 W/I-79 N toward Washington. Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 18 for I-79 N toward Pittsburgh. Take exit 96 for PA-488 toward Portersville/Prospect. Turn left onto PA-488 W/E Portersville Rd. Turn right onto US-19 N. Turn left onto PA-108 W/Harlansburg Rd. Turn left onto Bodziach Rd. Turn left onto Midway Rd. Turn right onto Livestock Alley. Destination will be on the right.

From West - Columbus Area

I-71 N to I-76 E to I 80 E - Entering Pennsylvania - Take exit 4A to merge onto I-376 E. Keep left at the fork to continue on US-422 E. Keep left to stay on US-422 E. Exit to stay on US-422 E toward Butler.

Continue on US-422 E. Take PA-388 N Turn right onto PA 108 (Harlansburg Rd) Turn right onto Midway Rd, Turn right onto Livestock Alley. Destination will be on the left.

## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

General Cluster and local information: Mark R. Kennedy (412) 638-4821 E-mail: mkr404@outlook.com Parking Attendants & Club Officials will be on duty and exhibitors are expected to follow their instructions. The clubs will not be responsible for any vehicles. Towing will be at owners expense. Handicapped vehicle parking available - No handicapped RV parking. Parking at the discretion of cluster personnel ONLY. No person shall open electric boxes. If you have a problem, please contact fairgrounds personnel. No generators after 11:00 P.M. or before 5:00 A.M. except at the discretion of the event committee. Buildings locked from 9:00 P.M. until 6:00 A.M. each night. No dogs overnight in buildings. No crates, private exercise pens, strollers or grooming allowed under the pavilion or ringside. Exhibitors will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and tables. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children each day of the shows. NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18 SHALL OPERATE ANY MOTORIZED OR ELECTRIC VEHICLE, INCLUDING GOLF CARTS. Neither the show superintendent nor the clubs will be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog on the show grounds, whether as a result of an accident or any other cause. It is clearly understood that every dog entered in these shows are in the care, custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. ALL TROPHIES MUST BE CLAIMED EACH DAY OF THE SHOWS. NONE WILL BE MAILED. NOTE: There will be no clean-up persons available for ring clean up. ***Each person handling a dog will be responsible for clean up of their own dog in the ring.***

### NO PRACTICING ALLOWED IN RINGS AT ANY TIME.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the event's Show Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Professional handlers\*, household members and current assistants\*\* to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. For a detailed description of the National Owner-Handled Series, please visit the AKC website NOHS pages at:

\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

\*\*A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

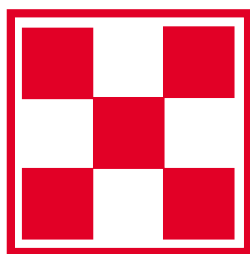
