Preface: The tradition of competitive purebred dog events predates 1884 – the year the American Kennel Club (AKC) was founded. Those involved in these sports share core values, including a strong commitment to sportsmanship and a welcoming, respectful culture that embraces the diverse community united by a love of dogs.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: Conformation, Performance, Companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can – and should – coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

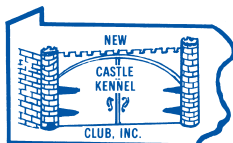

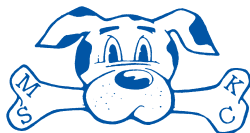

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. For a detailed description of the National Owner-Handled Series, please visit the AKC website NOHS pages at:

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

**A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

- The persons handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
- To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

Best Bred By Exhibitor

Best bred-by exhibitor involves the winners of the Bred-By Exhibitor classes. Even if one dog or bitch has beaten another by virtue of receiving winners or reserve from the classes, all return to the ring for the judging. This is a separate Special Attraction. What happened in the regular classes has no bearing on this award.

Best Puppy

Best puppy involves the winners of the 6-9 and 9-12 puppy classes. Even if one puppy has beaten another by virtue of receiving winners or reserve from the classes, all four puppy class winners return to the ring for the judging of best puppy. This is a separate Special Attraction. What happened in the regular classes has no bearing on the best puppy award.

SPACE FOR UNENTERED DOGS WILL NOT BE PROVIDED AT THIS SHOW. An exercise area will be provided for littering your dogs. Your cooperation will be greatly appreciated in helping to keep the grounds clean. Exhibitors will be responsible for the cleanliness of the show grounds and exercise areas. A cleaning fee may be assessed to any exhibitor who does not clean up their grooming area. Please do your part in keeping these attractive grounds in the same condition you entered them. Anyone found to be in violation of these policies may be subject to a bench show hearing.

Exhibitors should bring their own chairs.

Exhibitors must be prepared to wear a mask in the ring if requested by the Judge.

NOTE: Please always watch children, as some dogs are not used to active children. So, for safety's sake, teach them to respect all dogs. Neither the Clubs, Owner of the site nor the Show Secretary will be responsible for any injuries.

It is understood that each club associated with the Keystone Saint Celebration reserves the right to substitute any unavailable prize(s) with one(s) of equal or greater value. Prizes must be claimed the day of the show(s). None will be mailed. Unclaimed prizes will become property of the club which offered said prize.

Entries must be received by 12 PM Eastern on Wednesday April 29, 2026 at the home of the event secretary, or when the entry limit of 100 dogs/per show is reached, whichever comes first after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted EXCEPT as provided for in Chapter 11, sec 6 of the rules applying to dog shows.

Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable by email. The person accompanying a dog must show the email as proof of entry for admission before the dog will be received. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please call the Event Secretary at 706-306-9440. Make All Checks and Money Orders payable to Northern New Jersey Saint Bernard Club, FOREIGN exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS.

Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Entries received without funds will not be accepted. The Show giving clubs assume no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$4.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. An AKC Recording Fee of \$4.50 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.)

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, ex-

cused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators.

The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline (877) 252-3229.

Post Dated or Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Giving Clubs will add a collection fee of \$20.00 plus any bank fees incurred to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries: Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Errors on Entry Blanks: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Each Owner and Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed & submitted the entry form.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Division 2 is comprised of: Delaware, New Jersey, New York & Pennsylvania

For complete Conformation Championship requirements see Chapter 16 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows

The Points toward a Championship shall be awarded to the Winners Dog and Bitch of each breed or variety based on the actual number of dogs or bitches competing in that breed or variety.

If the dog designated Winners Dog or Winners Bitch is also awarded Best of Breed or Variety, the dogs of both sexes that have been entered for Best of Breed or Variety competition and that have been defeated in such competition, shall be counted in addition to the dogs that completed in the regular classes for its sex in calculating championship points.

If the dog designated Winners Dog or Winners Bitch is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed or Variety, the dogs of its own sex that have been entered for Best of Breed or Variety competition that have been defeated in competition for Best of Opposite Sex, shall be counted in addition to the dogs that completed in the regular classes for its sex in calculating championship points.

After points have been computed for Winners Dog and Winners Bitch subject to the above two stipulations, the dog awarded the Best of Winners shall be credited with the number of points calculated for Winners Dog or Winners Bitch, whichever is greater.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, or from which all awards are withheld shall not be included. Any dog which shall have won fifteen points shall become a Champion of Record, if six or more of said points shall have been won at two shows with a rating of three or more championship points each and under two different judges, and some one or more of the balance of said points shall have been won under some other judge or judges than the two judges referred to above.
